The content of the program is structured on the basis of the competence approach. In accordance with this, students develop and improve communicative, linguistic, linguistic (linguistics) and cultural competences. In the educational

process, the formation of these competences takes place during the study of any topic, since all types of competences are interrelated.

Special attention is paid to the formation of oral and written speech skills of foreign students. The learning of lexical units is facilitated by their correspondence to a certain speech situation. The speech orientation of the content is strengthened, which is manifested in the number of teaching hours (120 hours). A positive moment is the presence of the number of hours for independent work of students and various forms of creative activity.

The course provides boundary and final controls in the form of modules and exams.

The program provides mastering of the main topics of the Russian language course, the use of all types of analysis of language units.
